Bull City Little League is pleased to announce the creation of an Ambassador Program for previous BCLL players that have "aged out" of the league and still would like to volunteer for the benefit of the league. The program is intended for 13 to 17-year old volunteers with approval from their parent/guardian.

BCLL Ambassadors will assist at events including, but not limited to, skills evaluations, opening ceremonies, player/coach clinics, fundraisers, hosted tournaments, Challenger games, closing ceremonies and may work in the concession stand, direct parking, help on the field, etc. The ambassador program will be administered by the league Vice President to track volunteer hours, submit for outside consideration or recommendation, and/or develop the ambassador's resume for employment or college applications.

It is anticipated that up to 8-12 Ambassadors will be chosen for 2020 by the committee.

<u>Application period</u>: February 1st – March 10th, 2020

Required Documentation

<u>Copy of most recent school report card (or other academic record) should be submitted</u> <u>with the application</u>. (Ambassadors must <u>show continued</u> acceptable academic performance to participate in the program.)

Financial: The cost of the Ambassador program may be up to \$25 (depending on any available sponsorships). This money will be used to provide each Ambassador with a designated BCLL Ambassador shirt. This payment is due at the time of the distribution of Ambassador shirts (if selected). *Please make note of any financial hardship in the comments.*

Expectation/Commitment: By submitting your application, both you as an applicant and your parent/guardian understand that this is a commitment to BCLL. This commitment is to the BCLL Board and also to all of the players & families that make up the organization. The expectation is that you will attend as many events as possible and support the Ambassador program by demonstrating good conduct and responsibility while in an official Ambassador capacity. Failure to participate in 60% or more of the required events, representing the league in a negative manner, or failing to maintain good academics will result in a review and possible dismissal from the program. If selected, after a review of your application, you will be asked to sign an acceptance and code of conduct form.

Ambassadors are expected to assist at least two (2) Challenger games for the Spring season. Challenger division games are typically Saturday afternoon at 1:00 PM.
